Introduction

The third edition of AKSU's Junior High School library project was successfully organized on Saturday, July 23rd, 2022.

The union's chief patron, Prof. Wazi Apoh led the team to present books to five (5) Junior High schools in Kpando.

The beneficiary schools were:

- 1. Immaculate conception Junior High School
- 2. Seventh Day Adventive Junior High School
- 3. Kpando Konda M/A Junior High School
- 4. Kpando Gabi M/A Junior High School
- 5. Anglican M/A Junior High School

Funding, Purchase, and Distributions of books

Funding for the project came from key members of the AKPINI ELITE GROUP and other well-meaning natives of Kpando both home. Members of AKSU also contributed to this worthy cause. The union was able to raise a total of Three Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Ghana Cedis (Ghc3750) for the project.

The following books were acquired and distributed to the schools

- 1. Aki Ola Mathematics for JHS 15 Copies
- 2. In Scope Integrated Science for JHS 15 Copies
- 3. Golden English for JHS 15 Copies
- 4. Assorted story books and past questions for JHS 30 Copies

Prof. Wazi Apoh again gave the union ten (10) copies of his latest book on Kpando titled "REVELATION OF DOMINATION AND RESILIENCE: UNEARTHING THE BURIED PAST OF THE AKPINI..." to be donated to the schools.

The books were shared among the four schools proportionately. The team started the donation and interaction with the students of the Immaculate Conception JHS, followed by S.D.A JHS, Kpando Konda M/A JHS and Anglican M/A JHS respectively, and finally at Kpando Gabi M/A JHS.

AKSU members took turns to give inspiring and motivating speeches to the school pupils and inspired the students to work hard in order to attain higher heights.

The schools were very appreciative of the support given and thankful for the presence of Akpini Students

They also requested for more of our philanthropic activities such as vacation tutoring in Maths, English and General Science to help educate them in order for them to achieve greater heights in education like AKSU members.

Overall, thirteen (13) JHS in Kpando have so far benefitted from our Annual 'KPANDO JHS LIBRARY BOOKS PROJECT'

Challenges

Our major challenge during this year's project was funding. The fund raised was not enough so the Union

had to sacrifice other funds to finance this project. The inability to secure enough delayed the project from the earlier scheduled date.

Also, the team did visit the Anglican Junior High School but could not meet the students due to circumstances beyond their control. Their share of the books is currently in the possession of the Chief Patron.


